

The New Emergency Department waiting room provides comfortable seating for those seeking care.



The New Patient Entrance is staffed 24-hours a day and serves as a centralized registration area for patients.

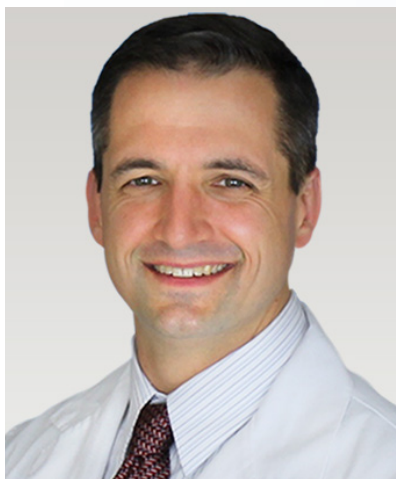

COLQUITT REGIONAL NAMED A “TOP RURAL HOSPITAL”

On December 3, 2014, the Leapfrog Group named Colquitt Regional as a Top Rural Hospital. This award is given to hospitals nationwide for demonstrating excellence in hospital safety and quality through the Leapfrog Hospital Survey. Out of all eligible hospitals, this award is given to less than seven percent each year.

Leapfrog’s Top Hospital award is acknowledged as one of the most prestigious distinctions any hospital can achieve in the United States. **Colquitt Regional Medical Center was one of 94 Top Hospitals nationally and the only hospital in Georgia to make the list.**

The Leapfrog Group’s assessment includes data related to:

- The outcome of patients’ healthcare
- Use of resources
- Structure of management to prevent errors

Performance of hospital care qualifications are based on:

- Rates for high risk procedures
- Hospital’s ability to prevent medication errors

PATIENT SAFETY IS OUR TOP PRIORITY

On November 6, 2014, Colquitt Regional was honored with an “A” grade for its Hospital Safety Score. This is an evaluation of how well hospitals protect patients from errors, injuries and infections. The Hospital Safety Score is compiled under the guidance of the Nation’s leading experts on safety and is administered by The Leapfrog Group, an independent industry watchdog.

The Hospital Safety Score uses 28 measures of publicly available hospital safety data to produce a single “A”, “B”, “C”, “D”, or “F” score representing a hospital’s overall capacity to keep patients safe from preventable harm.

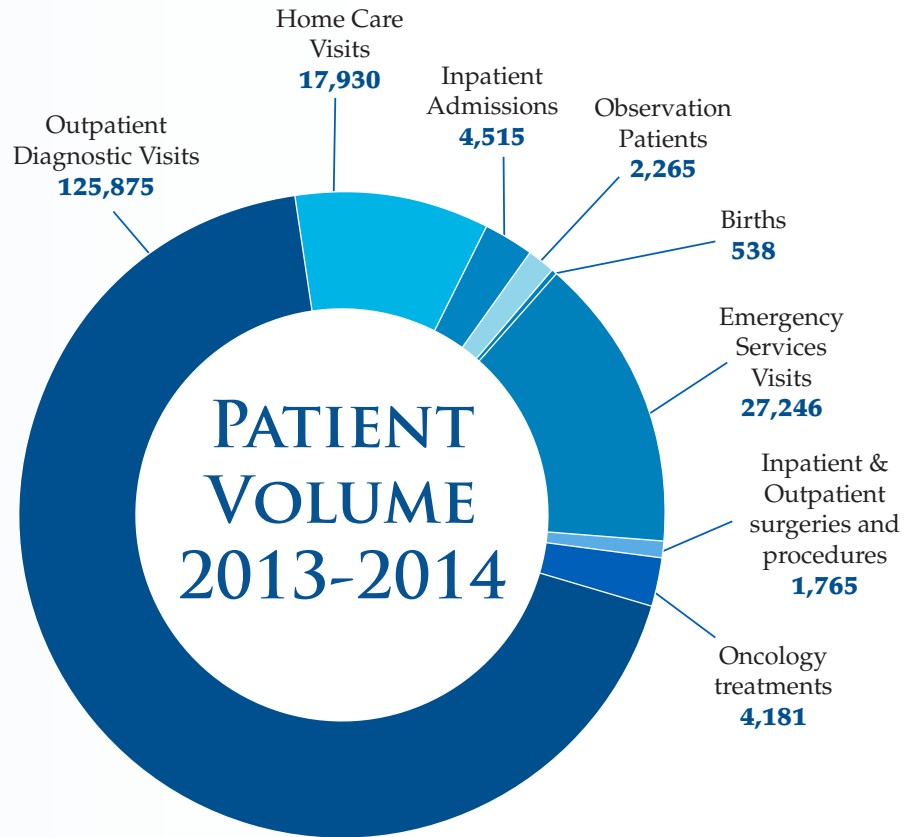

COLQUITT REGIONAL MEDICAL FOUNDATION

Foundation gifts total over \$1 million in 2014

Early in 2014, the Foundation launched a 1.5 million dollar capital campaign to assist the hospital with its \$30 million expansion and renovation project. The foundation's campaign focus was to purchase new equipment needed in the new Emergency Department, Surgical Suites and in the Intensive Care Unit. At the grand opening of these renovated areas, Foundation Chairman Jimmy Jeter announced that donations and pledges received from the community totaled over \$2 million. This exceeded our original goal!

Colquitt Regional Medical Foundation's year in review:

- Gifts received in 2014 totaled \$1,462,629. Three fundraisers were also conducted during the year and raised \$47,609 for the Foundation.
- Twenty-two donors joined the Foundation's Founder's Society, a lifetime recognition designation for those who have given \$10,000 or more. In addition, thirteen new businesses joined Business Partners recognition levels.
- This year, the foundation partnered with the Colquitt County Schools in funding a telemedicine program in three schools. This program will connect the school health nurse with a healthcare provider offering medical care to students while at school.
- The Foundation provided the hospital with car seats for new parents who couldn't afford this necessity, medical care for hospice patients, funds for an education center in the oncology department and equipment for home health services. In addition, 15 wheelchair ramps were funded to aid people in Colquitt County.
